
Night Nature Alliance Owl House Placement Tips

When properly placed, Eastern Screech
Owls are the most common inhabitant of
these houses, but Saw Whet Owls may also
use them.

Eastern Screech-Owls live and breed successfully in farmland, suburban landscapes, and city parks.



Screech Owl boxes should be attached to a freestanding pole (you can use a tree, but squirrels will likely make a home within the box before screech owls find it) 15-30 feet above the ground.

This should be within 15 feet of at least one roost that provides a view of the box. This branch is where the parents will stand guard when not actively hunting or feeding the young. As they defend against predators-remember that they will most likely view people & pets as predators and attempt to keep you from their young- so the further from an occupied area that you can place it, the better!
